


# 2023 District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Smallbore Rifle Match (3-P & Silhouette)

## **Guiding Principles & Contest Rules**

This event will follow the Texas 4-H Shooting Sports rules for the respective discipline except as noted below. The focus of these events is to provide 4-H members involved in shooting sports in District 12 with an opportunity beyond what may be available in their county.

### Smallbore Rifle (3-P) Match Rules

- 1. Texas 4-H Smallbore 3-Position Indoor Rifle Rules (v2019) will be followed except as noted in these contest rules .
- 2. All entries must be submitted through <u>4-H Online</u> by individual 4-H members within the registration period (March 21—April 14, 2023). There will be no late registration or on-site registration.
- 3. Targets will be ORION 50 foot standard targets (10 record bulls and two sighters surrounded by a ring).
- 4. Scoring will be based on NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules (v 01/16) and scored using the Orion Scoring System Technology.
- 5. All targets will be placed on stands all at once. There will not be any switching of targets between rounds (position changes). Seniors will place all 6 targets, Intermediates all 3 targets, and Juniors all 3 targets at once.
- 6. Age divisions will be Senior (9th-12th grade), Intermediate (6th-8th grade), and Junior (3rd-5th grade) as of 8/31/2022.
- 7. Courses of Fire
  - \*Seniors 3 Position (Prone, Standing & Kneeling) with two targets (20 shots) in each position. *Note: Sitting cannot be substituted for kneeling.*
  - \* Intermediates 3 Position (Prone, Standing & Kneeling) with one target (10 shots) in each position. *Note: Sitting cannot be substituted for kneeling.*
  - \* Juniors 1 Position (Prone) with three targets (30 shots) in this single position.
  - \* Seniors & Intermediates will shoot Prone/Standing/Kneeling in that order.
- 8. Time Limits
  - \* Seniors Prone (10 min per target); Standing (20 min. per target); Kneeling (15 min. per target)
  - \* Intermediates Prone (10 min per target); Standing (20 min, per target); Kneeling (15 min, per target)
  - \* Juniors Prone (10 min per target) x 3 targets.
- 9. Distance from the firing line to the target will be 50 feet.
- 10. Coaches must complete and sign a "Team Designation Form" prior to beginning of the first heat/relay.
- 11. All firearms must remain cased at all times with an OBI (open-bolt indicator), until instructed by the Range Officer.



# 2023 District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Smallbore Rifle Match (3-P & Silhouette)

## **Guiding Principles & Contest Rules**

This event will follow the Texas 4-H Shooting Sports rules for the respective discipline except as noted below. The focus of these events is to provide 4-H members involved in shooting sports in District 12 with an opportunity beyond what may be available in their county.

### **Smallbore Rifle (Silhouette) Match Rules**

- 1. Texas 4-H Smallbore Rifle Silhouette Rules (v2018) will be followed except as noted in these contest rules .
- 2. All entries must be submitted through <u>4-H Online</u> by individual 4-H members within the registration period (March 21—April 11, 2023). There will be no late registration or on-site registration.
- 3. Targets will be 1/5 scale steel targets (chicken, pig, turkey & ram) as per NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules. This may be modified onsite to accommodate range limitations, facilities, or time.
- 4. Scoring will be based on NRA Rifle Silhouette Rules (v 03/20) and scored using "Hit" or "Miss" beginning on the left and progressing to the right until stage is complete.
- 5. Distances will be 40, 60, 77, and 100 yards. Modifications may be made onsite to accommodate range limitations or facilities.
- 6. Age divisions will be Senior (9th—12th grade), Intermediate (6th—8th grade), and Junior (3rd–5th grade) as of 8/31/2022.
- 7. Courses of Fire (modification may be made as outlined above)
  - \*Seniors 40-shot course including 10 chickens at 40 yards, 10 pigs at 60 yards, 10 turkeys at 77 yards, and 10 rams at 100 yards
  - \* Intermediates 30-shot course including 10 pigs at 40 yards, 10 turkeys at 60 yards, 10 rams at 77 yards
  - \* Juniors 20-shot course including 10 pigs at 40 yards, and 10 rams at 60 yards
- 8. Time Limits
  - \* Ready time—15 seconds will be allowed between "Ready" and "Fire" commands.
  - \* Firing time—2½ minutes will be allowed for each bank of 5 targets
- 9. This is an individual event. There are no teams or team awards.
- 10. All firearms must remain cased at all times with an OBI (open-bolt indicator), until instructed by the Range Officer.
