SUBJECT: 2024 District 12 4-H Trap, Skeet & Whiz-Bang Shoot

The District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Committee is pleased to announce the 2024 District 12 4-H Trap, Skeet & Whiz Bang Shoot. This is a single-match event open to 4-H members statewide to be held March 23, 2024 at Mission Skeet & Trap Club, 1306 S. Conway Ave., in Mission, Texas (Hidalgo County).

Awards will be provided for each age division to includes Senior 2, Senior 1, Intermediate, and Junior. There will not be Ladies awards for HOA as has been done in the past. The courses of fire will include three events: Trap, Skeet and a Whiz-Bang qualifying match for a total of 150 targets combined.

Registration for this event will take place on *4-H Online* by selecting the “2024 District 12 4-H Trap, Skeet & Whiz Bang Shoot (March 23 – Mission)” event as well as completing the iClays online squadding registration. The registration period will be February 13 – March 7, 2024. Registration and fee information are also included in the flyer for your reference. The registration fee will be \$180 per contestant (150 targets). Only enrolled 4-H members (statewide) can complete online registration. This event is open to 4-H members statewide. **There will be no onsite registration. There will be a late registration fee of \$225.00. The deadline for Late Registration is March 13th. NO REFUNDS** will be given to any county and/or individual. This makes it very important for registrations to be correct. Payment is due prior to the event date. Please note, once you submit your registration for approval, you are agreeing to fulfill payment for registration regardless of whether or not you attend this event.
