**TO:** District 12 County Extension Agents

**SUBJECT:** 2024 District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Postal League – Smallbore Rifle, Shotgun, Archery, Pistol

The District 12 4-H Shooting Sports Postal League continues to be a large and successful event and we're excited to announce the 2023-2024 event details. The term "Postal" simply refers to this event taking place locally within your area using the US Postal Service to submit scores. Smallbore Rifle, Archery, and Pistol targets along with Shotgun scoresheets will be mailed from the District 12 office after the entry deadline. Participants in Shotgun events will provide their own clays. All record Rifle, Archery, and Pistol targets and shotgun score sheets must be mailed back to the District office, AND archery, pistol and shotgun scores must be submitted online as directed below, within the specified timeline.

Registration for these events will be administered through **4-H Online**. Select the “D12 4-H Shooting Sports Postal League” event. The **registration period** will begin on January 26, 2024, and conclude on February 20, 2024. Participants of these 4-H events should coordinate with their respective coach or county office to register. The **shooting period** will be between March 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup>. **All scoresheets/targets must be in the District office on or before April 10<sup>th</sup>**. If you are mailing the targets, they will need to be postmarked by April 5<sup>th</sup>.

Please view each shooting discipline guidelines document for specific information about submitting scores/targets. For county offices mailing targets, please consider possible delays in postal service shipping times, as it is your responsibility to get these targets in the district office by the deadline. For the shotgun, pistol, and archery disciplines, coaches/agents must **post the scores online** (<http://d124-h.tamu.edu/events/shooting-sports/>) by April 5<sup>th</sup> with official scorecards arriving at the District office on or before April 10<sup>th</sup>.

**There will not be a late registration period.** **NO REFUNDS** will be given to a county and/or individual. This makes it very important for registrations to be correct. Payment is due prior to the event date. Please note, once you submit your registration for approval, you are agreeing to fulfill payment for registration regardless of whether or not you attend this event.

An announcement flyer is also available to assist you in marketing this opportunity locally and among 4-H shooting sports members across the district.
