Program changes and tips for 2023-2024:

- FASFA IS NOW OPEN! PLEASE HAVE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS FILL OUT THEIR FASFA
- Collegiate Scholarships will not be given out in 2024.
 - Available Scholarships will be Baccalaureate, Technical, and Courageous Heart.
- Do not submit applications before fall grades have been added to the transcript!
- Once submitted, no updates will be allowed
- All applications must be submitted through the Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship Portal, you can find the link <u>HERE</u>
- Remember to use an email you will have access to after graduating high school.
- CEA's will not be using a verification form, you will receive a list of applications submitted by the deadline for approval and eligibility.
- ACT and SAT is not required again this year for the 4-H Opportunity Scholarship.

Goodluck to the 4-Her's applying for Scholarships this year! The key is to start early, and edit often before submitting!



DISTRICT 12 4-H COUNCIL OFFICER

NEW ELECTION PROCESS:

A meeting was held November 11, 2023 and District Council and 4-H voting delegates passed the following new items:

Election Scoring Process:

A. 10% of the score will be determined from the application received through 4-H Online.Applications will be reviewed and scored by impartial judges from outside of the district.B. 20% of the score will be determined from the interview.

C. 70% of the score will be determined from the popular vote casted by voting delegates.

The Voting Body will appoint an applicant from the officer candidates into vacant positions through a ballot. This will be determined on the day of Election Convention. Officers cannot hold more than one position.

I would like to remind CEA's for candidates that are interested in running need to attend at least one District 12 4-H Meeting. The next meeting will be held on April 6th at Fashion Sensation/Round-up in Falfurrias!
