GROUP ENROLLMENT START ENTERING NUMBERS TODAY

When entering data into group enrollment, you will see 4-H Online has several drop-down options to pick from. The program is now transitioning to 2 specific options for group enrollment. These are 4-H Special Interest or 4-H School Enrichment. Do not select any of the other options. How to decide which one to choose: anything that is coordinated through the school system (regardless of location) will be entered of 4-H School Enrichment. All other group enrollment will be entered under 4-H Special Interest.

DISTRICT 12 4-H COUNCIL OFFICER

APPLICATIONS ARE OPEN NOW!

A meeting was held November 11, 2023 and District Council and 4-H voting delegates passed the following new items:

Election Scoring Process:

A. 10% of the score will be determined from the application received through 4-H Online.Applications will be reviewed and scored by impartial judges from outside of the district.B. 20% of the score will be determined from the interview.

C. 70% of the score will be determined from the popular vote casted by voting delegates.

The Voting Body will appoint an applicant from the officer candidates into vacant positions through a ballot. This will be determined on the day of Election Convention. Officers cannot hold more than one position.

I would like to remind CEA's for candidates that are interested in running need to attend at least one District 12 4-H Meeting. The next meeting will be held on April 6th at Fashion Sensation/Round-up in Falfurrias!
