Contest Type

Qualifying:

- 1. Counties may send an unlimited number of teams to District 12 4-H Round-up Educational Presentation +
- 2. Seniors can participate at Invitational Texas 4-H Round-up Livestock Skillathon.

Contest Structure

Team ONLY

- 1. Teams may consist of 3-4 youth.
 - a. An exception to the age division is that juniors may move up to compete with an intermediate team, but intermediates or seniors may not move up or down to a different age division.
- 2. Teams must be declared the role of each participant in advance by the County agent on 4-H Online.
- 3. There are no individual entries in this contest.
- 4. The contest will be divided into four areas: identification, judging (which consist of meat cuts, wool and/or hay classes), quizzes (quality assurance quiz, and industry quiz.), and team exercises. Contestants will be divided into groups and have time limits for each station area.
