## **Contest Type**

# Qualifying:

- 1. Counties may send an unlimited number of teams to District 12 4-H Round-up Educational Presentation +
- 2. The top 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> place Senior teams qualify to compete at Texas 4-H State Round-up.
  - a. Senior teams must compete at District to qualify for State.

#### **Contest Structure**

#### **Team ONLY**

- 1. Senior Teams MUST consist of four (4) youth. No exceptions.
- 2. Intermediate & Junior Teams may consist of 3-4 youth.
  - a. An exception to the age division is that juniors may move up to compete with an intermediate team, but intermediates or seniors may not move up or down to a different age division.
- 3. Teams must be declared in advance by the County agent on 4-H Online.
- 4. There are no individual entries in this contest.

#### **Contest Rules**

The District 12 4-H Quiz Bowl contests will follow the State 4-H Quiz Bowl Rules & Guidelines found here: State Quiz Bowl Contest Rules & Guidelines

\*With the following exceptions

- 1. Junior & Intermediate Teams are allowed to have 3 member teams.
- 2. District 12 will NOT calculate or distribute individual awards in any of the Quiz Bowl events at the District Level.
